Planned - Subject & profile

Raha College provides the ideal ambience for one having a desire to pursue higher education in Three-year Degree course in the streams of Arts, Science and Commerce. The College has newly introduced Science and Commerce stream from the academic session 2015-17. Situated in a serene atmosphere within the town, the College offers an ideal location for teaching-learning units. It is located at a distance of one and half K.M. from Raha town Naren Charaih and can be approached from three main roads. It is only at a distance of 400 meter from the junction of NH-37 road toward Cherrapunji Railway junction. This unit of higher learning obtained its status public in 2015 and was reaccredited 'B' grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in the same year. The College has two distance education centers at present functioning under Gauhati University and Krishna Kanta Singh State Open University (KANSOU) offering BA and MA and various certificate and diploma programmes.

The dream of setting up a seat of higher learning in Raha was undertaken by Dr. Balu and Mr. Chakma. The first academic activities of Raha College started in 1996. At present the College offers degree courses in Arts, Science and Commerce for students of Scheduled Castes. The College is affiliated to Gauhati University and it has 21 faculty members. The college has been running its post graduate course in the academic session 2014-15. Apart from the post graduate course, the College runs the M.Sc course in Arts as per AICTE. The post graduate course has been giving emphasis on two vocational courses namely, Tourism, Platinum and Retail Management under UGC scheme of Community College. The College has rich faculty members, a modern library and a Computer Centre.
