- The Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC) is one the most essential camp for the cadets of the NCC. The duration of the camp is 10 days. During this camp, various drills and cultural activities arrange by the Bn NCC and supervise by the group headquarter. In this camp supervise by some prominent persons and interact with the cadets. During this period, from 2017 to 2022, Raha College attended 10 CATC Camp.
- 2. Army Attachment Camp is designed to physically develop the cadets and prepare to entry into the service of Indian Army. This camp generally lasted for 10 days. During this camp many Army Officers and rank holders interact with cadets and inspire to dedicate their life to the name of country.
- 3. Basic Leadership Camp is basically arranged to physically and mentally prepare future leader of the country from the cadets. In this camp besides various physical training, the moral values have also included in the programme schedule. Many religious fellows invite in the camp and give a platform to earn spiritual knowledge from their life.
- Republic Day Parade is the prestigious camp for each and every cadet. This camp is held on 26th January of every year. From September to December, four month training is arranged for the selection of RDC cadets.
- 5. As a part of "cleanliness drive" and "India is the best country" the EBSB is planned. During this camp cultural activities of the various parts of the country perform in a single platform. Best cultural event select in the camp and broadcast it worldwide.



Activity report on NCC Day celebration:


Activity report on world environment day:

The place is situated in west and southern side of Nagaon district and distance from Guwahati city to Amsoi 70 km. & from Nagaon town 45 km.in the middle side of Shilchang and Dharamtul. There is a forest road by which one can come to Amsoi east side of 37the National Highway, these knows Khalahat Reserve Forest and9 K.M.long one way road by which one can reach beautiful places of Amsoi. Though modern education till has not able to touch everyone in Amsoi, few educated people of Amsoi trying to practice lactureture . They published their writings in many News paper and magazines' in Assam , few writer also published book in Assamese and Tiwa language. A branch of Asom Sahitya Sabha (An Assamese literary organization) and Tiwa Mathanlai Tokhra (Tiwa leatreture organization) also in Amsoi area. There are many cultural organizations in the villages. They display their performance in different festivals in Amsoi and outside of Amsoi area. One can enjoy Bihu, Tiwa, Karbi, Jhumur, Nepali etc. dances though these cultural organizations. In ancient time Amsoi area was a part of Sahari Tiwa kingdom. In present time Tiwa Kingdom is not in power, the Tiwa people of this area is still maintaining their Tiwa kingdom memory through "RAJA MELA" at Sahari in the month of Assamese new year "BAHAG" (April). In this "RAJA MELA" people displays their respect as per rules of Tiwa present acting King of Sahari. On that day acting kind of Sahari Kingdom openly calls a sitting of his parliament as per rules and regulations of ancient time. This is also a regular part of Sahari Tiwa "RAJA MEAL". Some of the tribal peoples cultivates their "Jhum Kheti" in the hill area. To protect the Jhum kheti from elephant, monkey they creates a small house with tree branches called "Tongi Ghar".

It was a great experience for our students to know about the new place and to know about the life style, economic condition and the history of the place Amsoi.

Activity report on Swachha Bharat Abhiyan :

A Swachha Bharat Abhiyan programme was organized by the NCC unit of Raha College on 2/02/2017 and 7/12/2019 within the college campus and outside the campus also.
