
1. POLICY DOCUMENT ON ENVIRONMENT AND ENERGY USAGE

Raha College believes in sustainable development in all its activities and as such the following areas are given due importance for implementing the policy:

- · Clean and Green campus.
- · Ban on single use of plastic in the campus.
- Energy conservation and Management.
- · Waste Management solid, liquid and E-waste Management.
- · Creating an awareness for a green and healthy environment.

#### **CLEAN AND GREEN CAMPUS:**

- The College has abundance of greenery and it is prohibited to cut trees in the college campus.
- · To undertake tree plantation drive in the College campus.
- To minimize vehicle emission in the campus and to encourage pedestrians and bicycle riders.

#### PLASTIC FREE ZONE:

- The College is a plastic free zone.
- The canteen of the College has been advised to use steel crockery, dishes, tumblers, etc.
   Single use plastic items should be completely avoided.

- · E-waste is managed by Kareng technology, Guwahati.

  environment.
