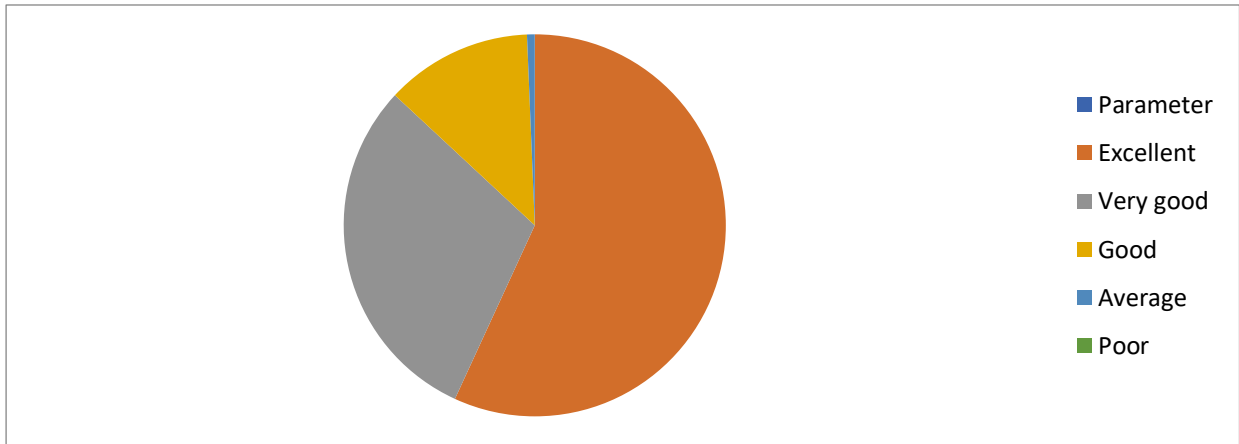

Developing analytical skills

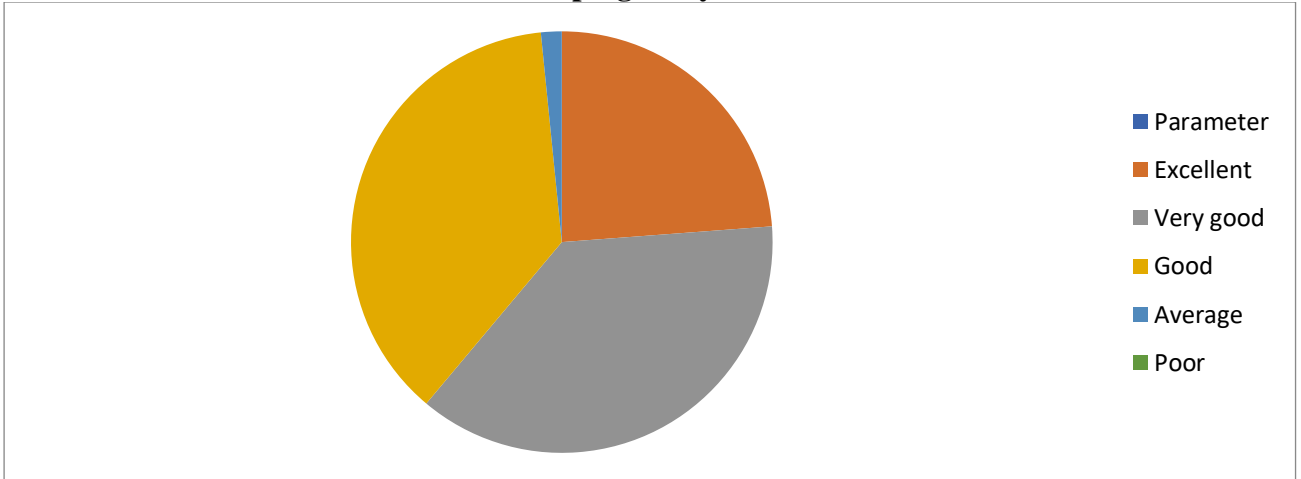

Availability of optional subjects within the course

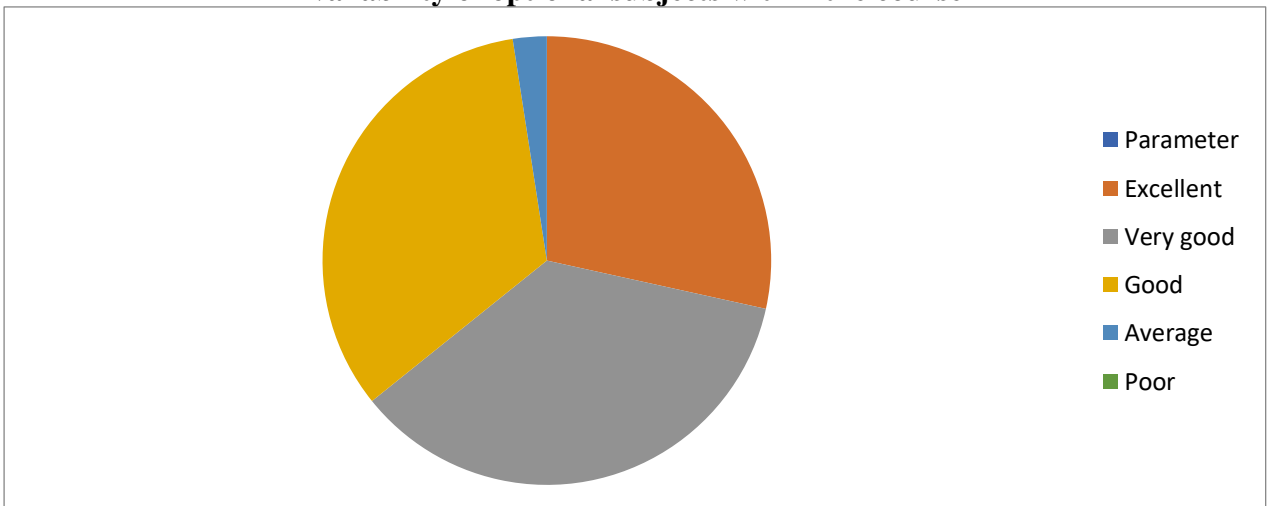
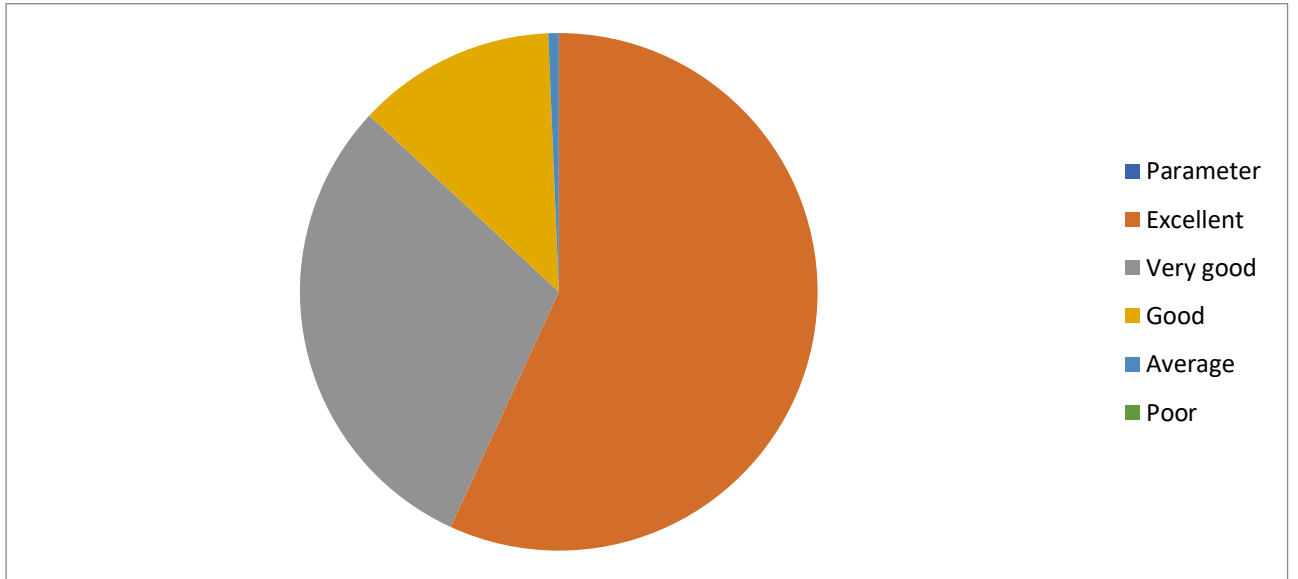

Knowledge base

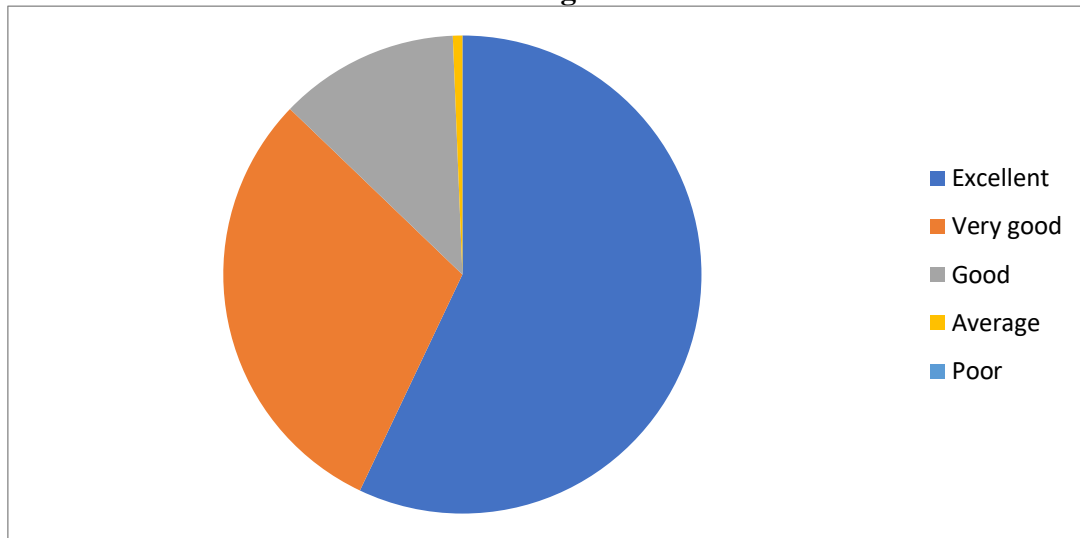

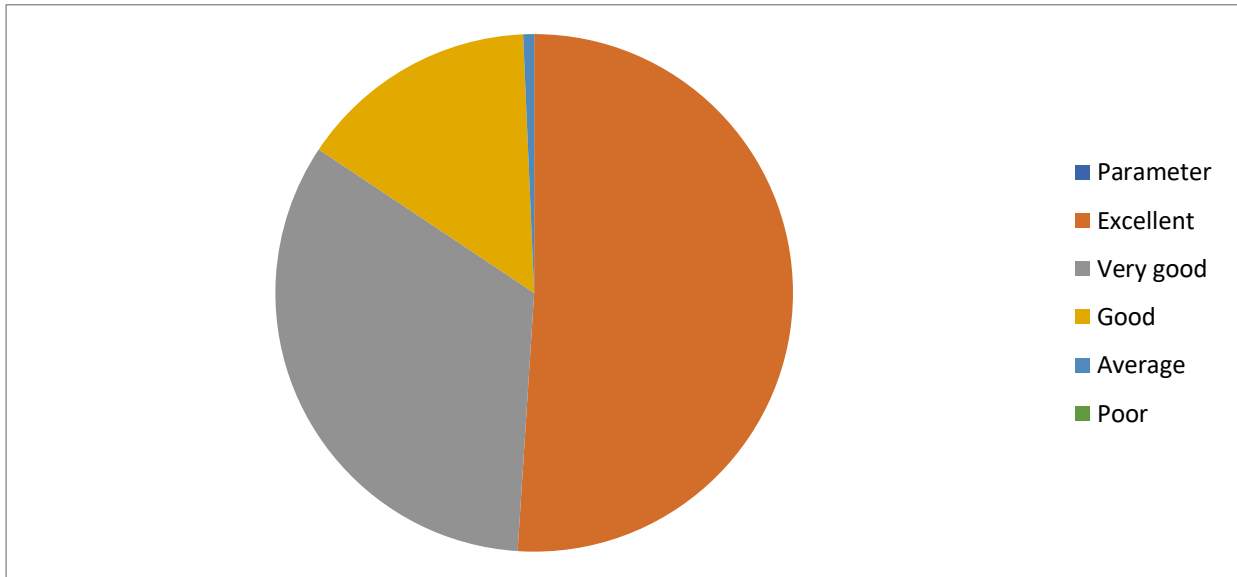

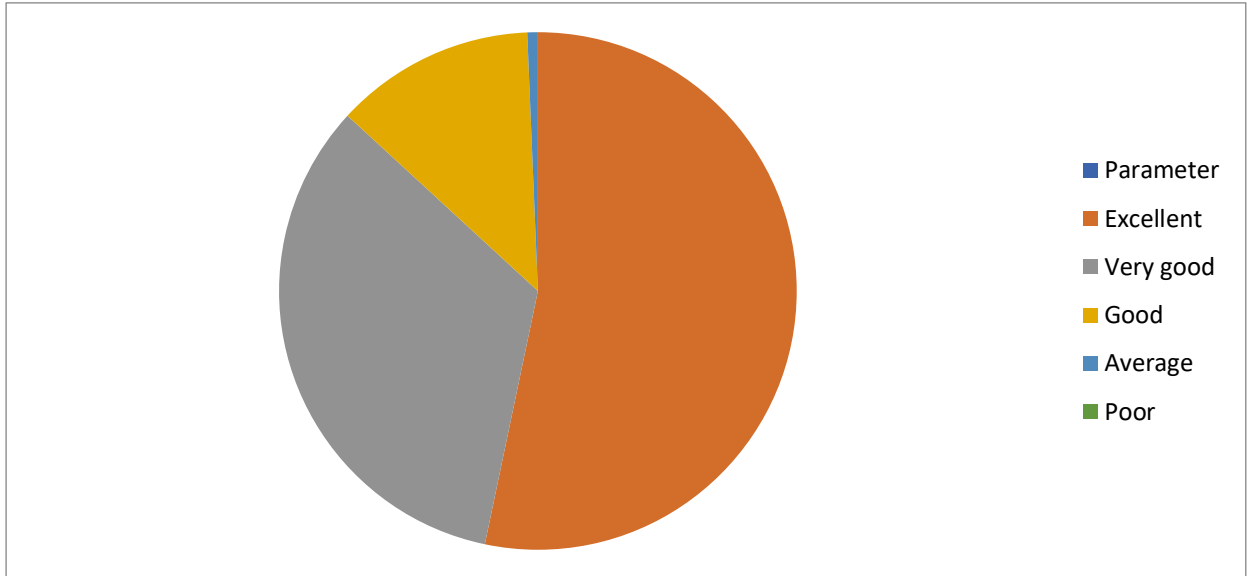

Ability to design and evaluate assignment

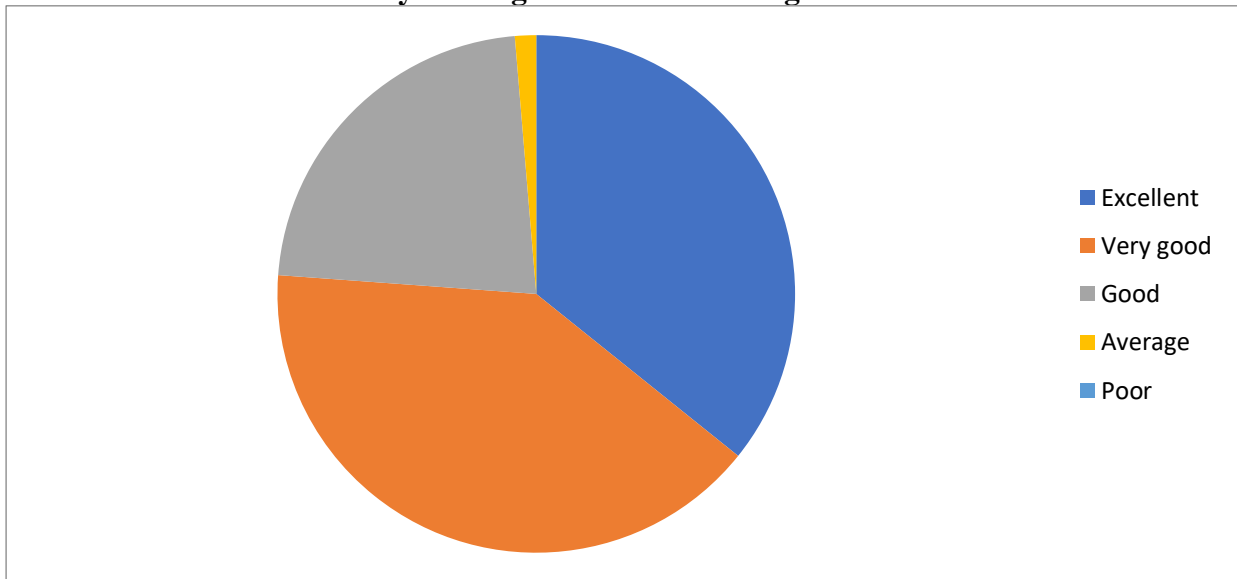

Coverage of syllabus

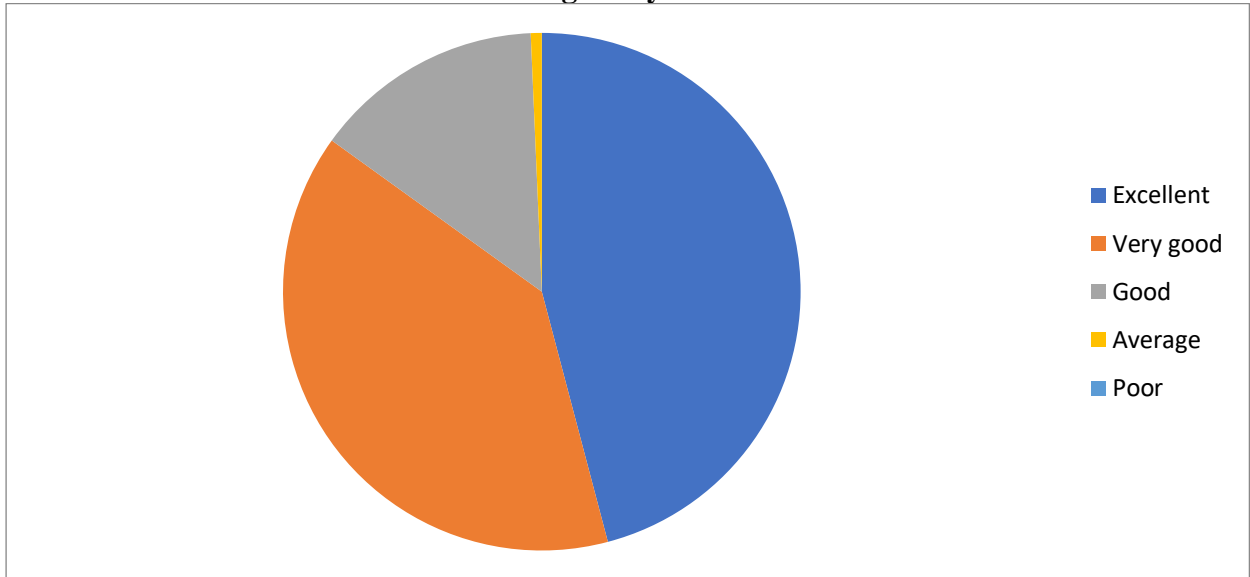

Encouragement by the teacher for student participation

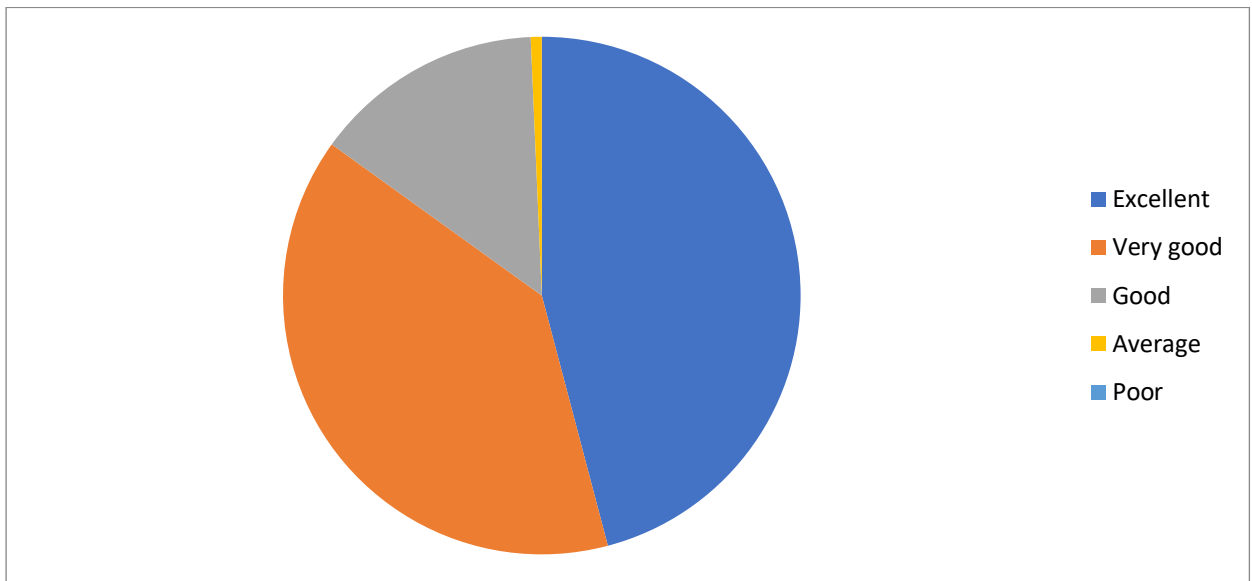
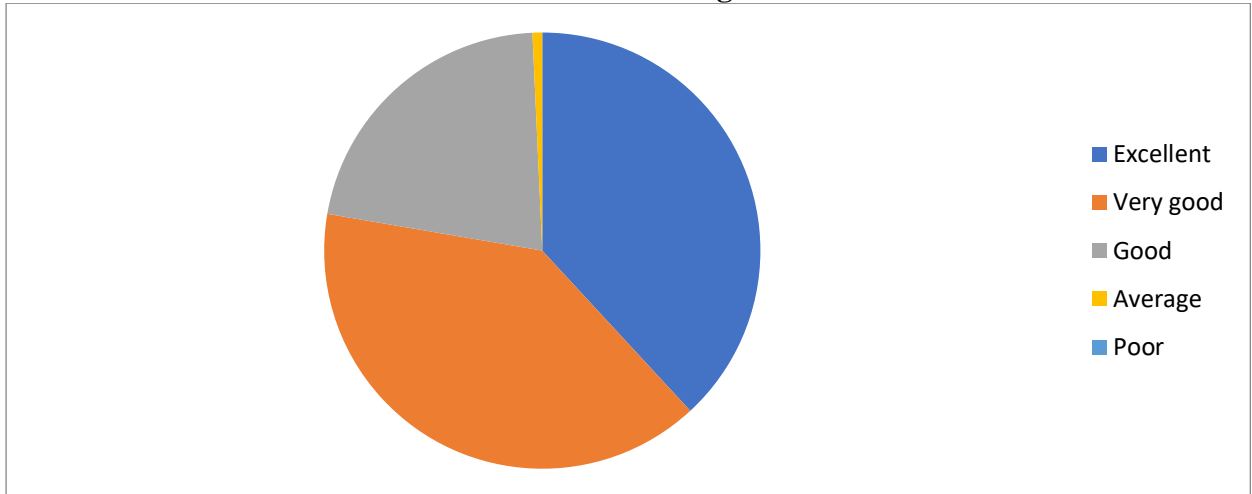

Availability of materials for prescribed reading

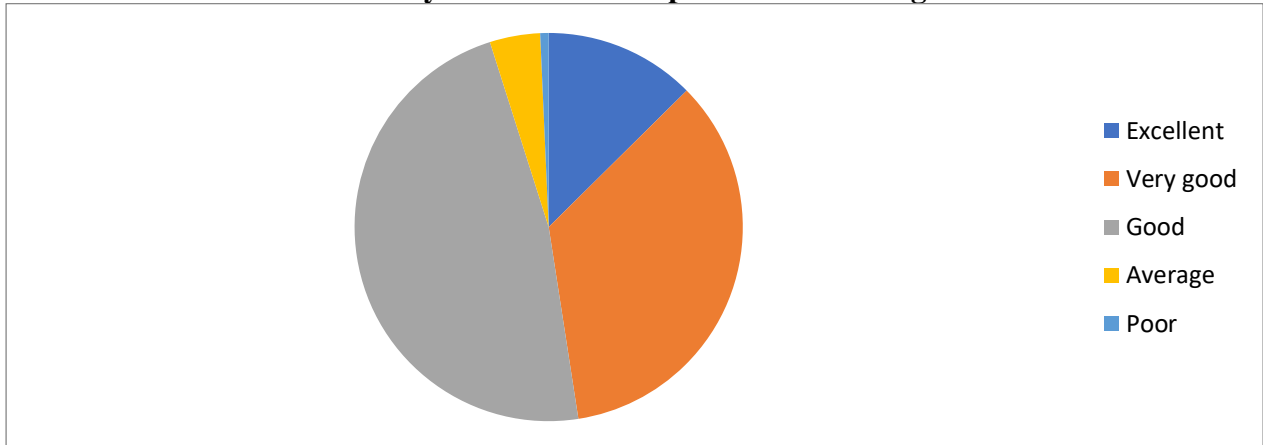

Availability of reference books

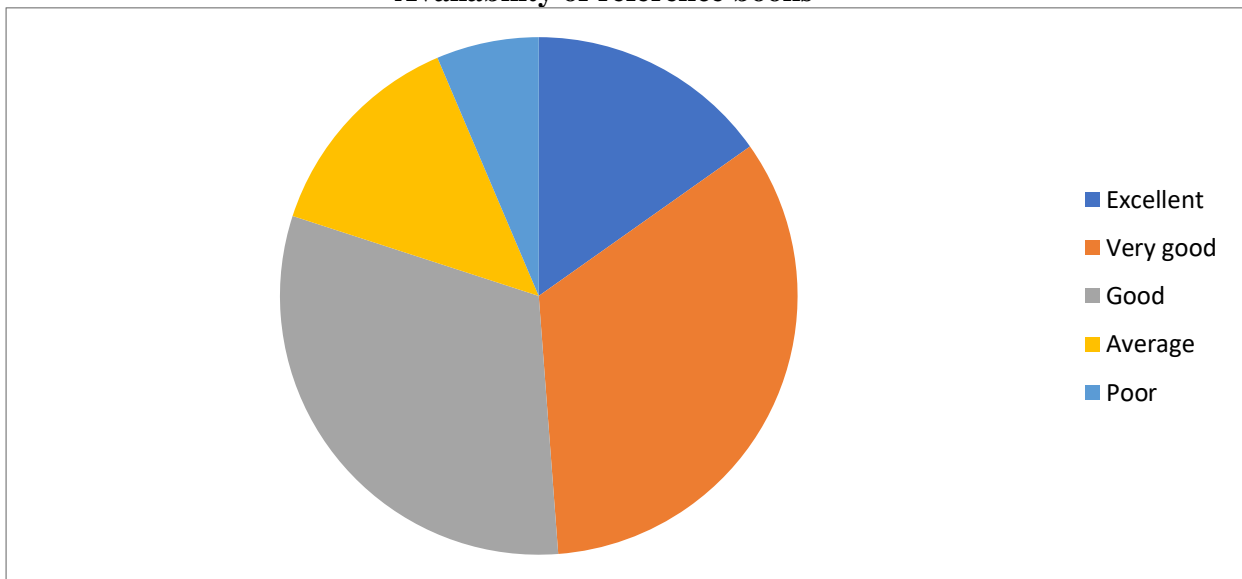

Accessibility of books and journals

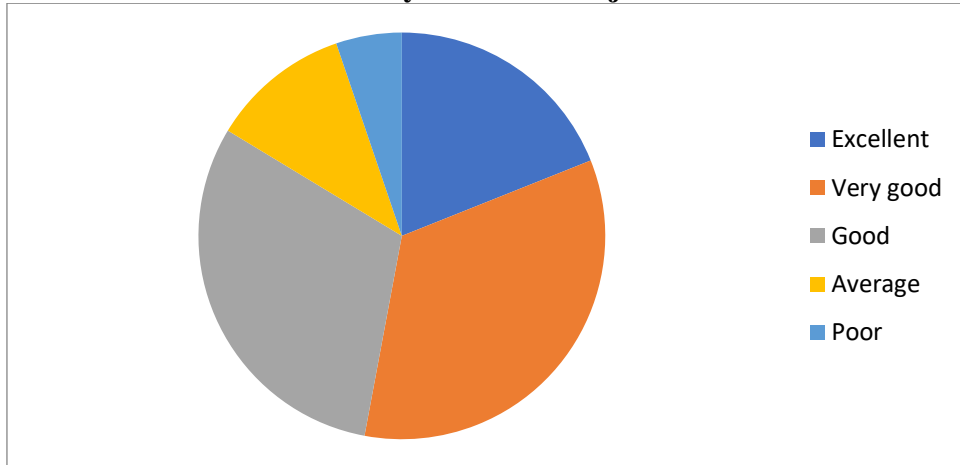

Availability of latest editions

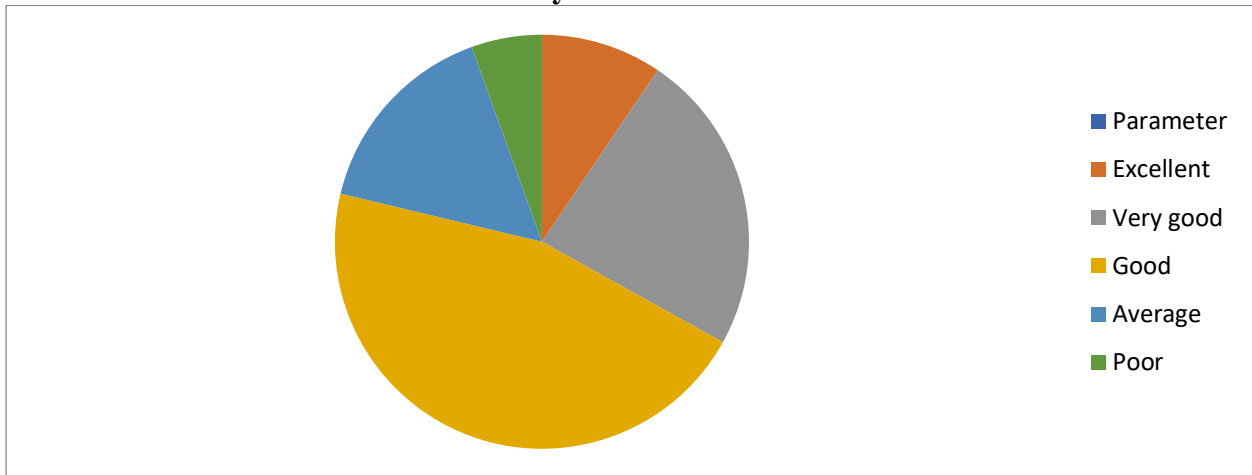
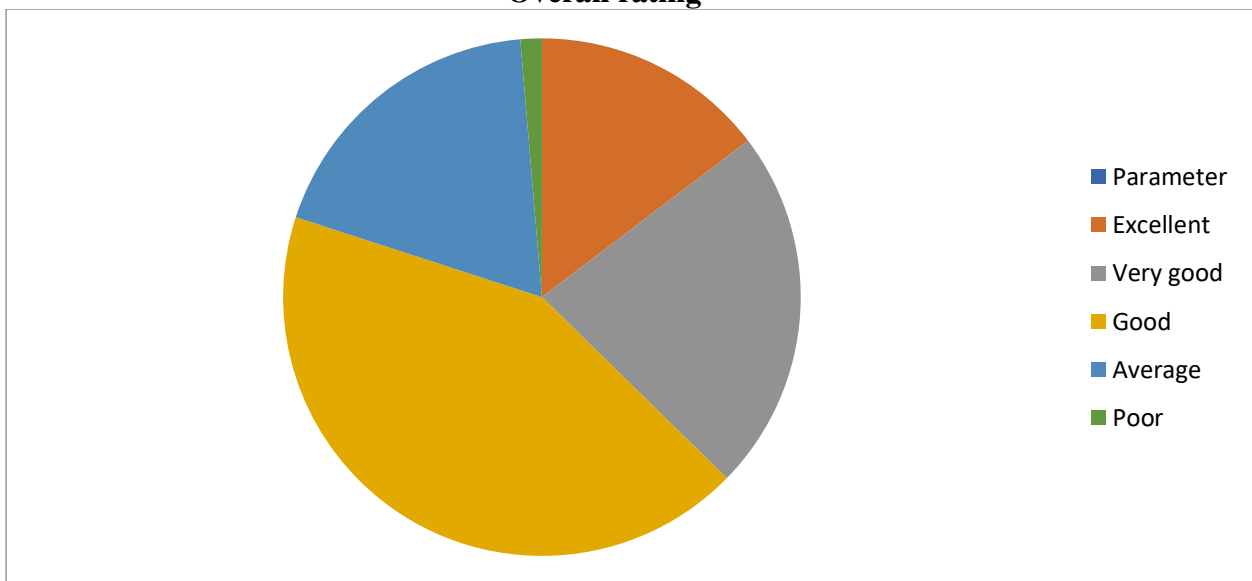

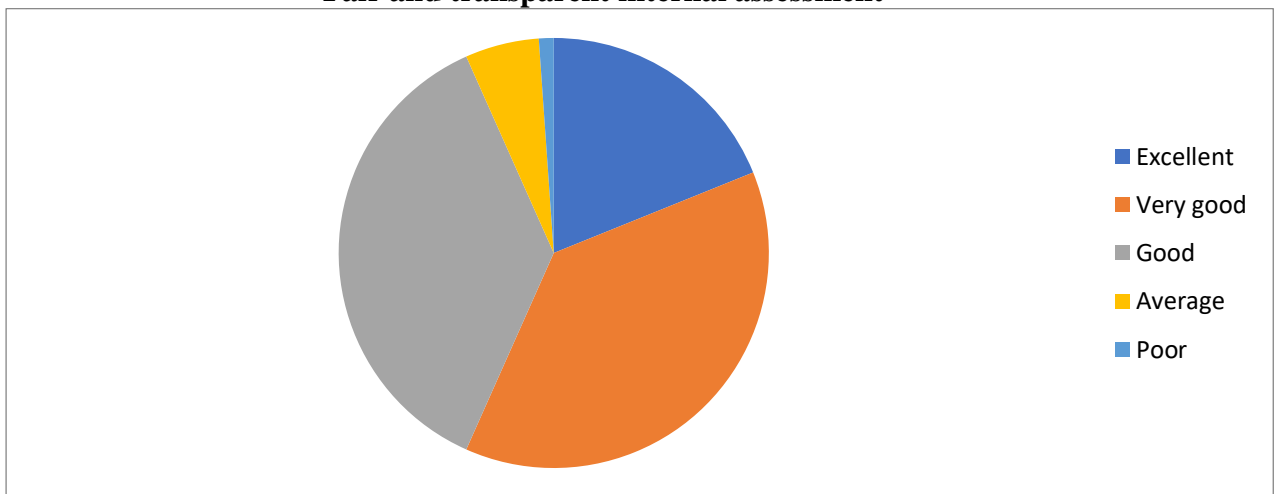
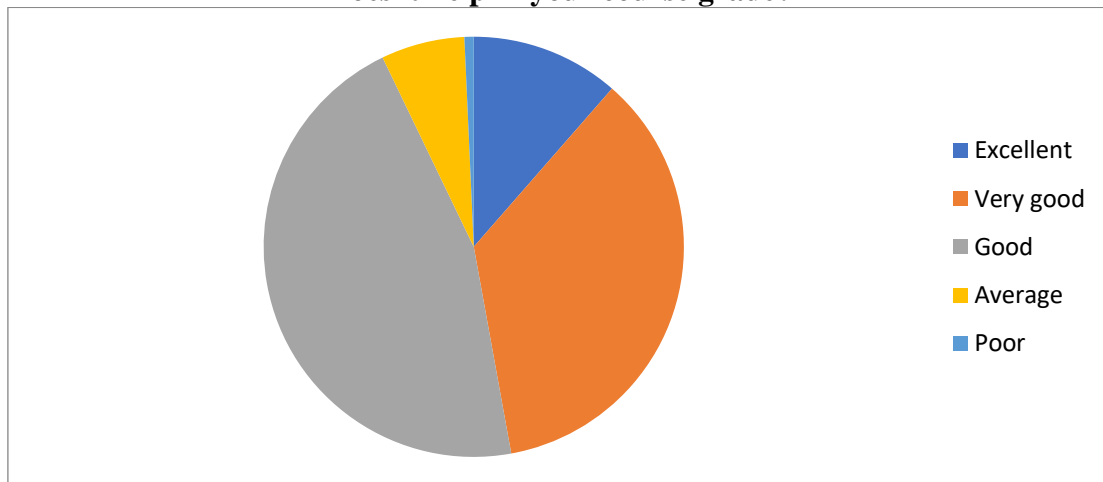

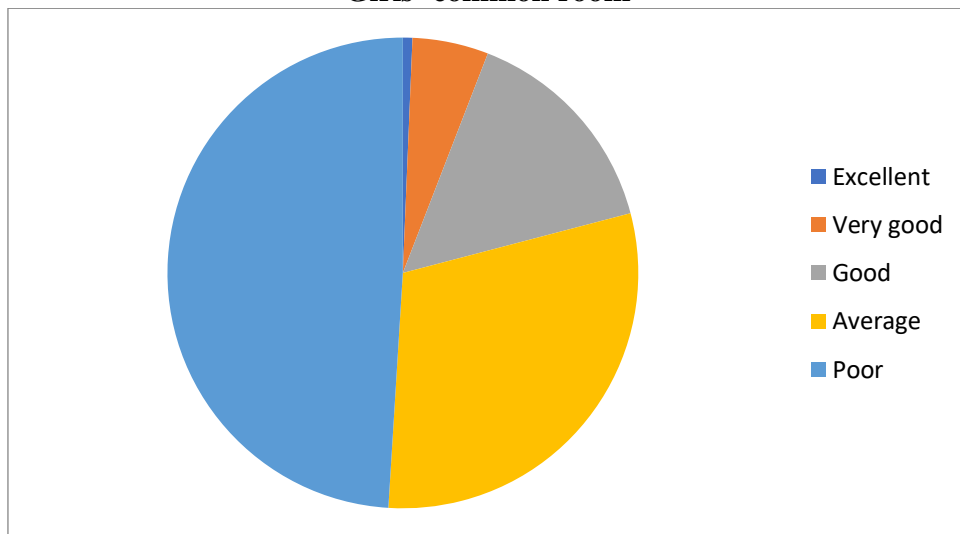

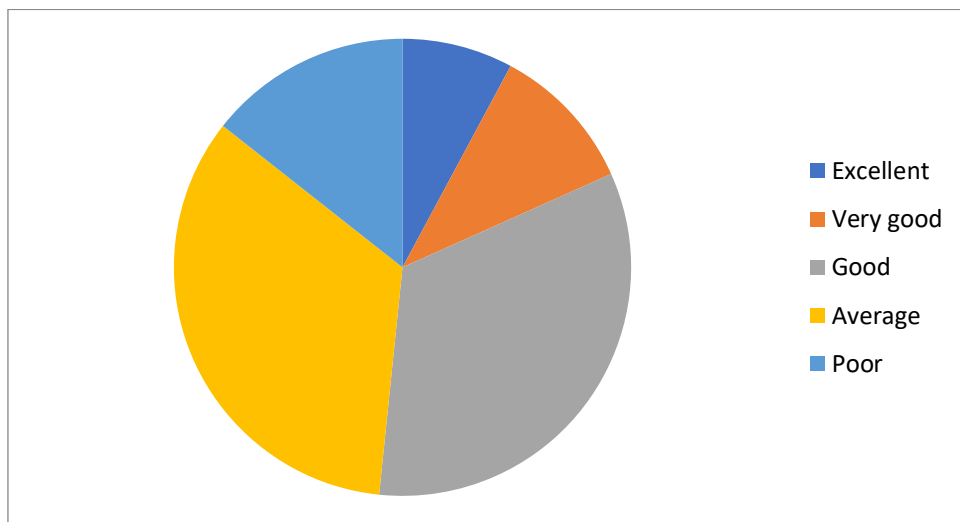

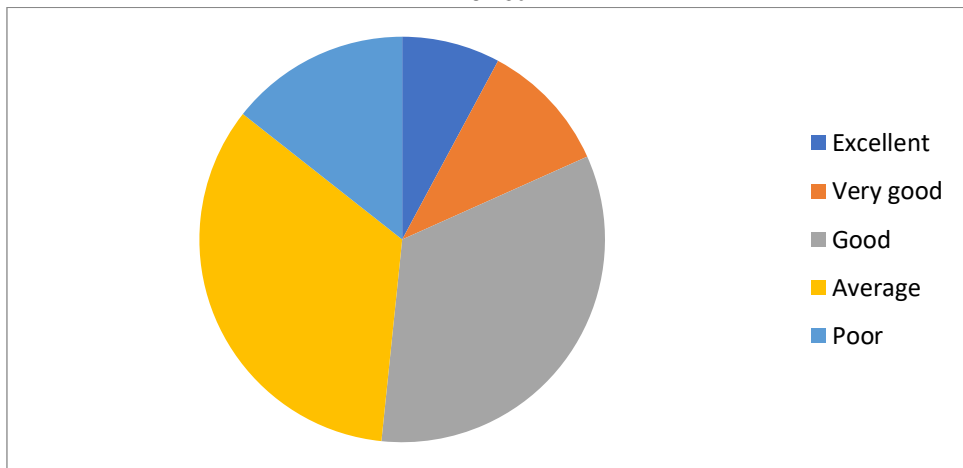
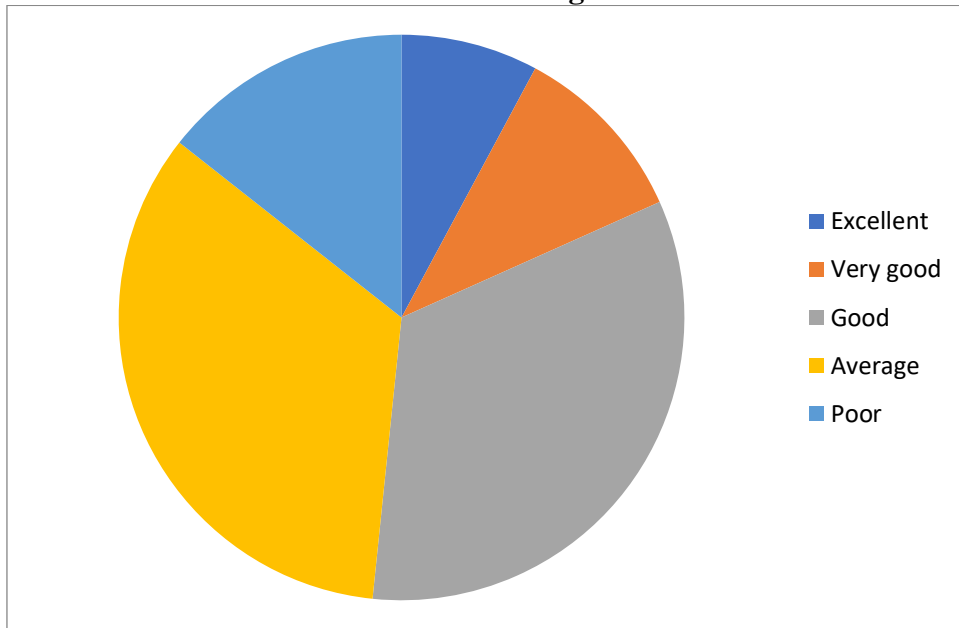

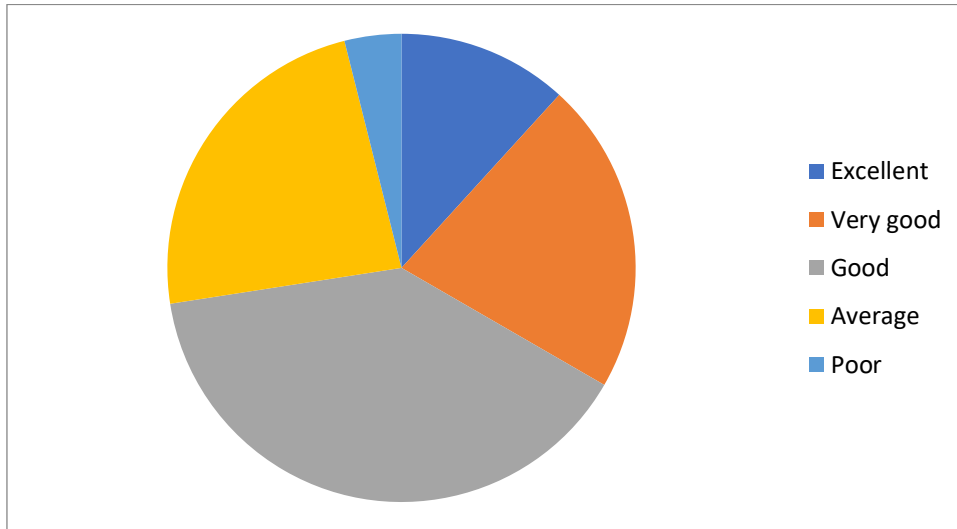

Grievance Redressal

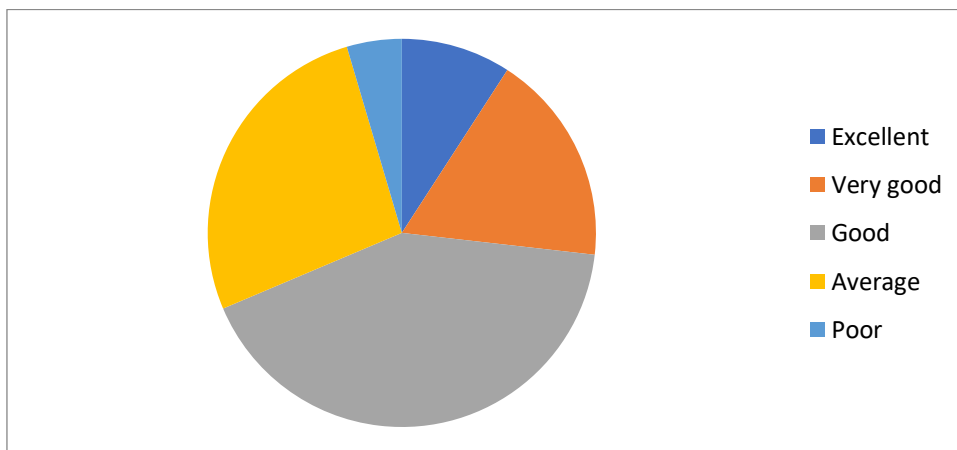

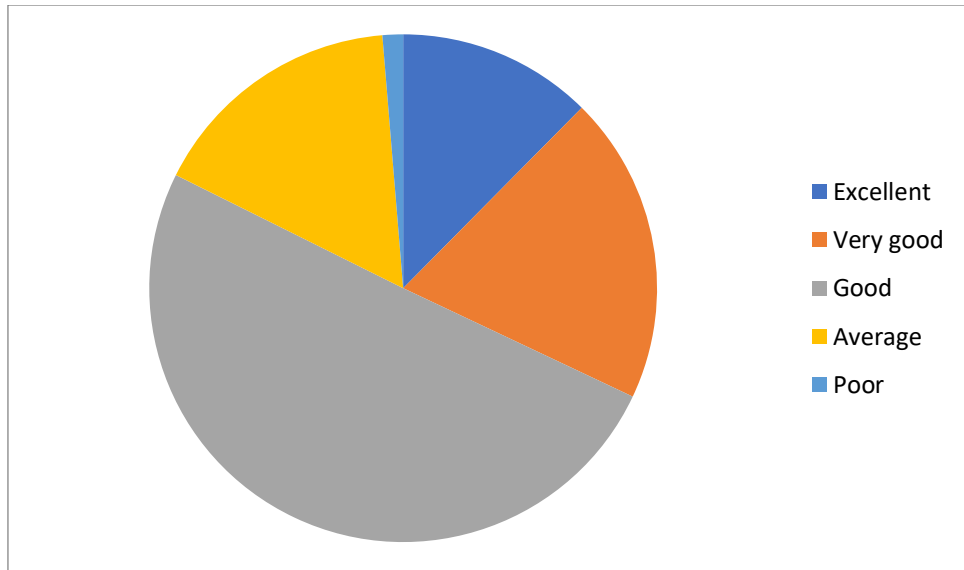

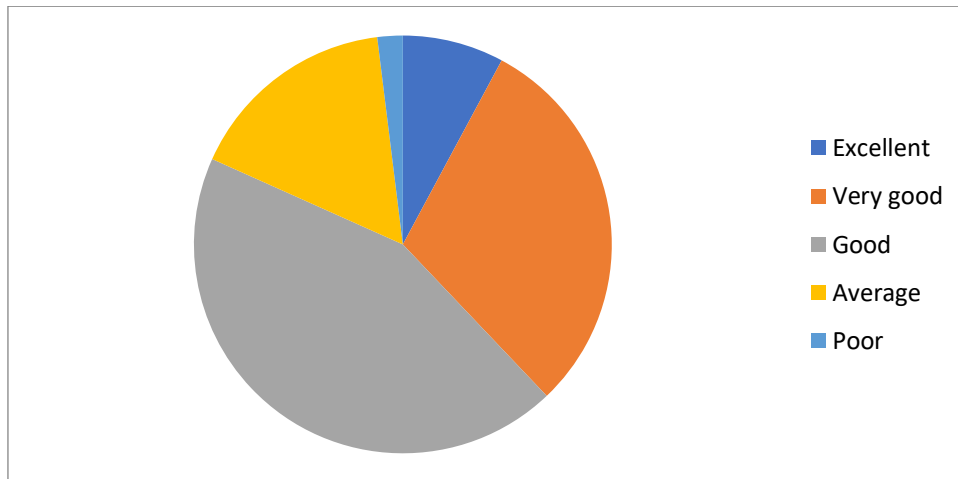

Student-Student Union Relationship

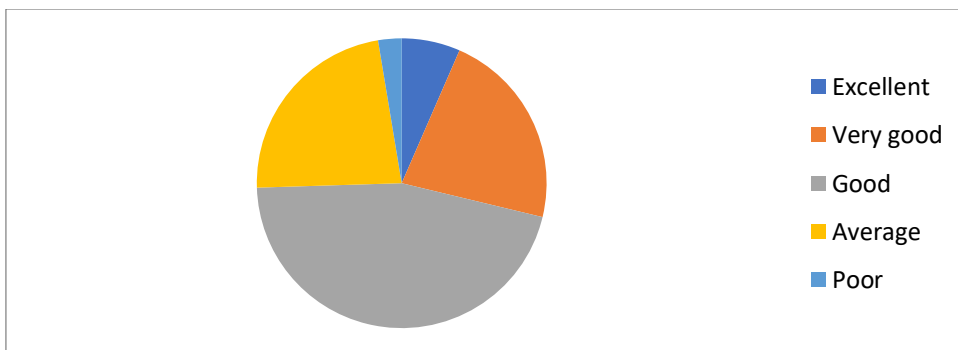

Availability of Extra-Curricular Activities

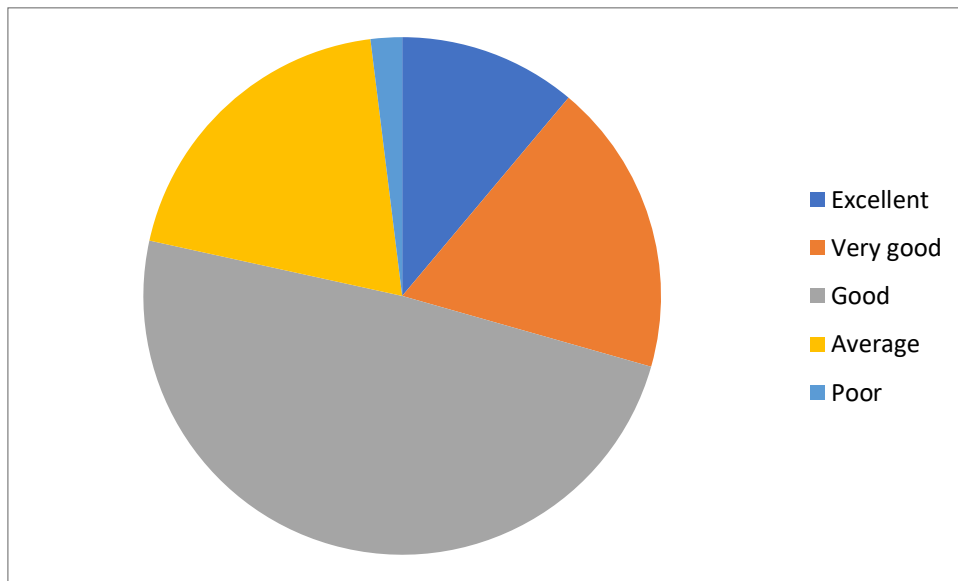
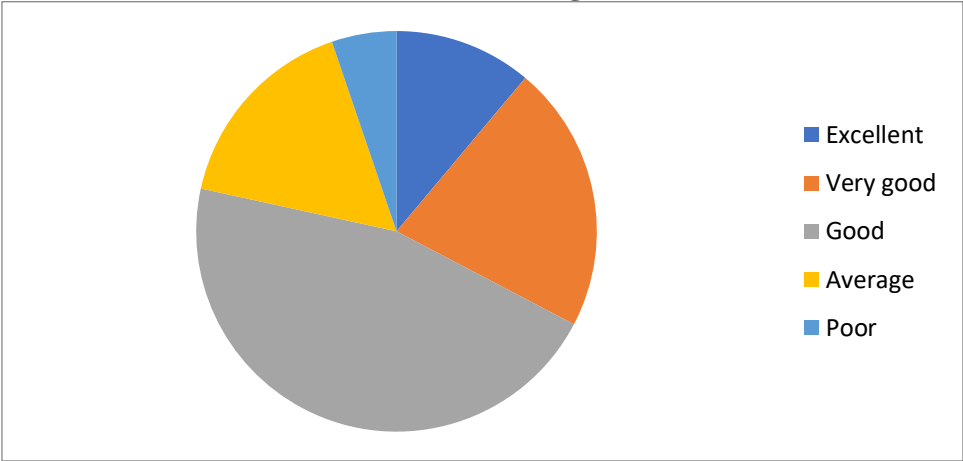

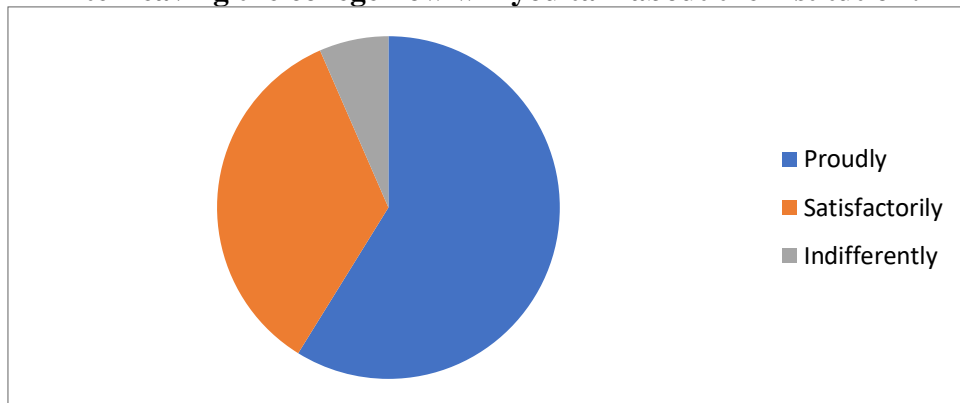
