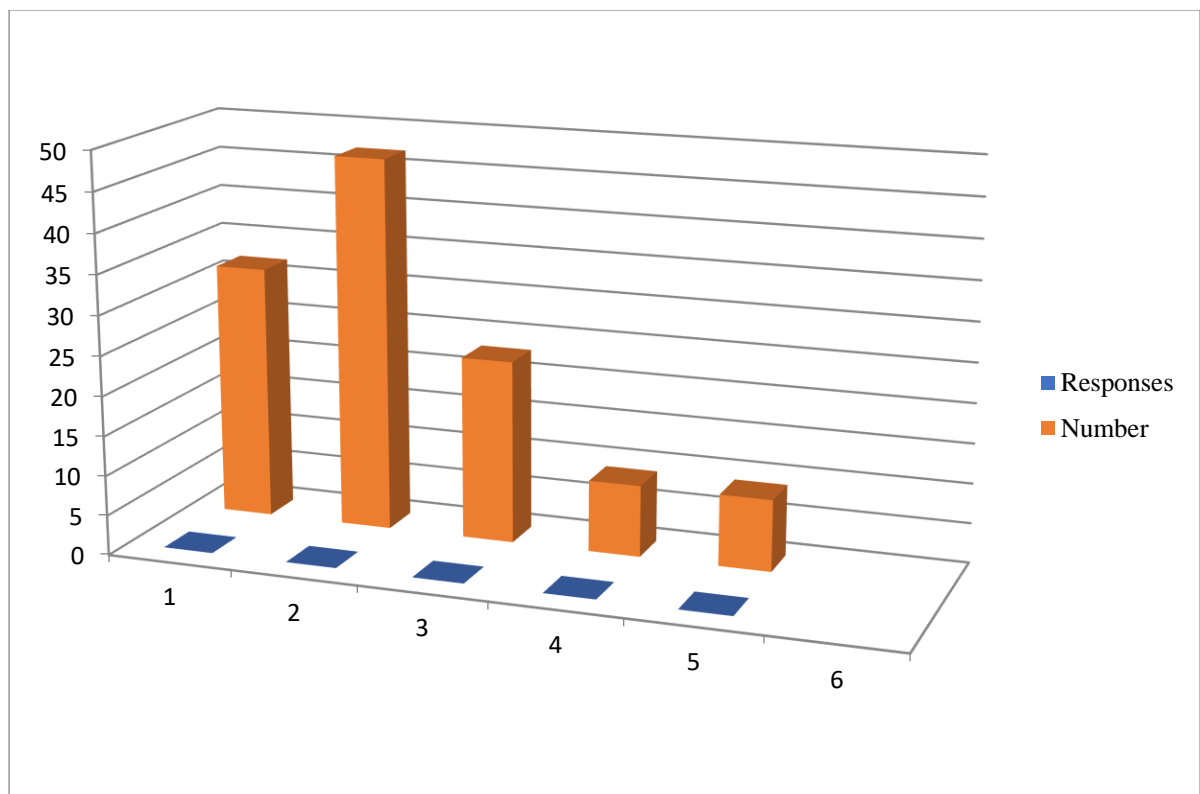

Feedback on admission procedure

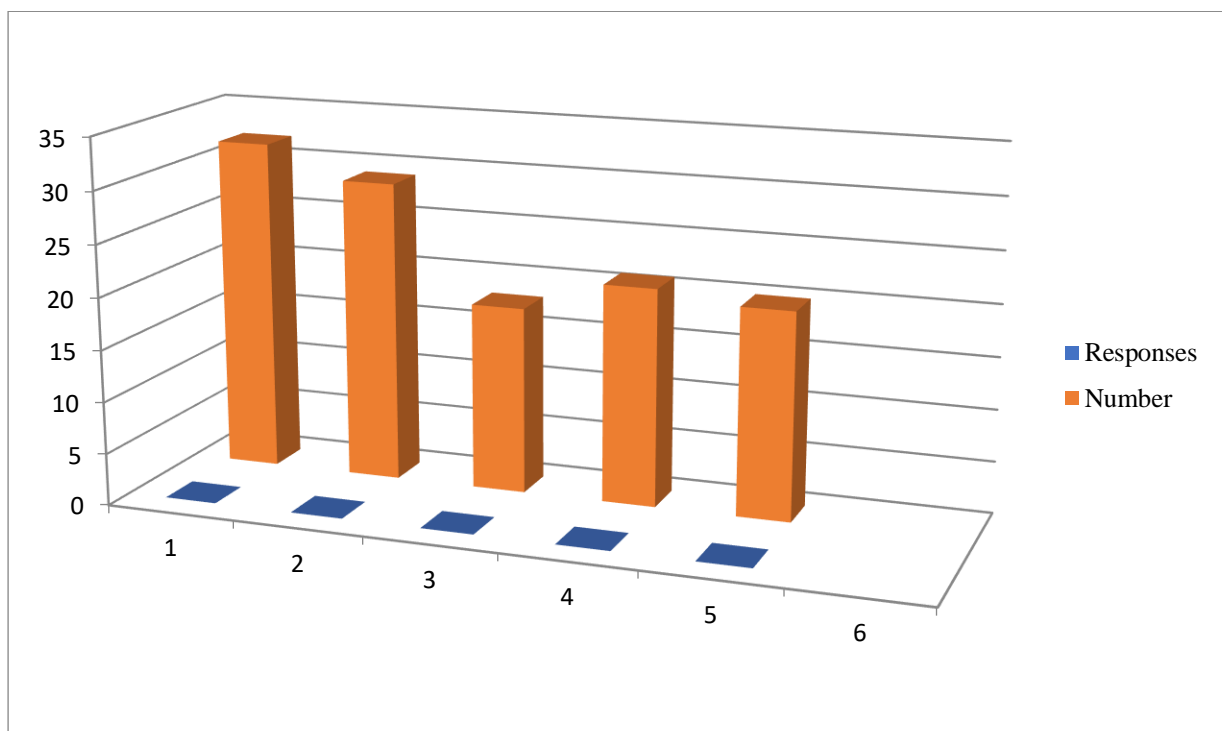

Feedback on Library resources

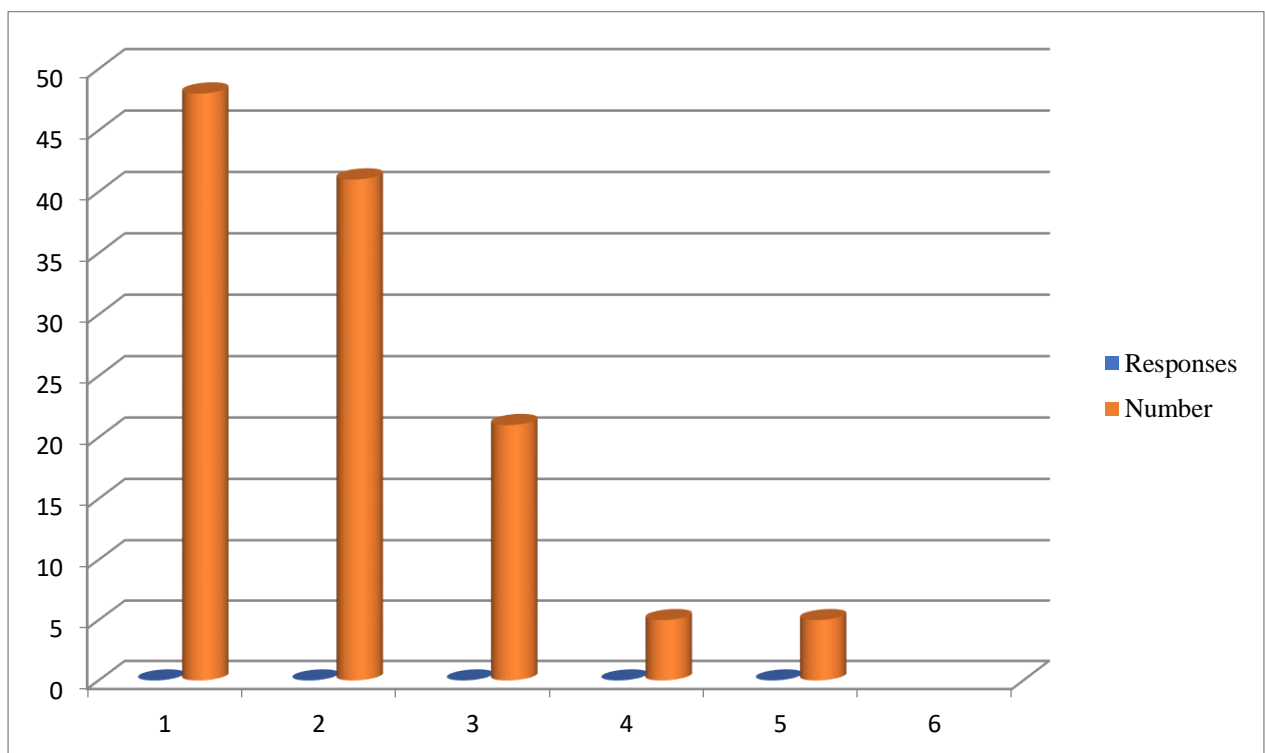

Feedback on Curriculum transaction

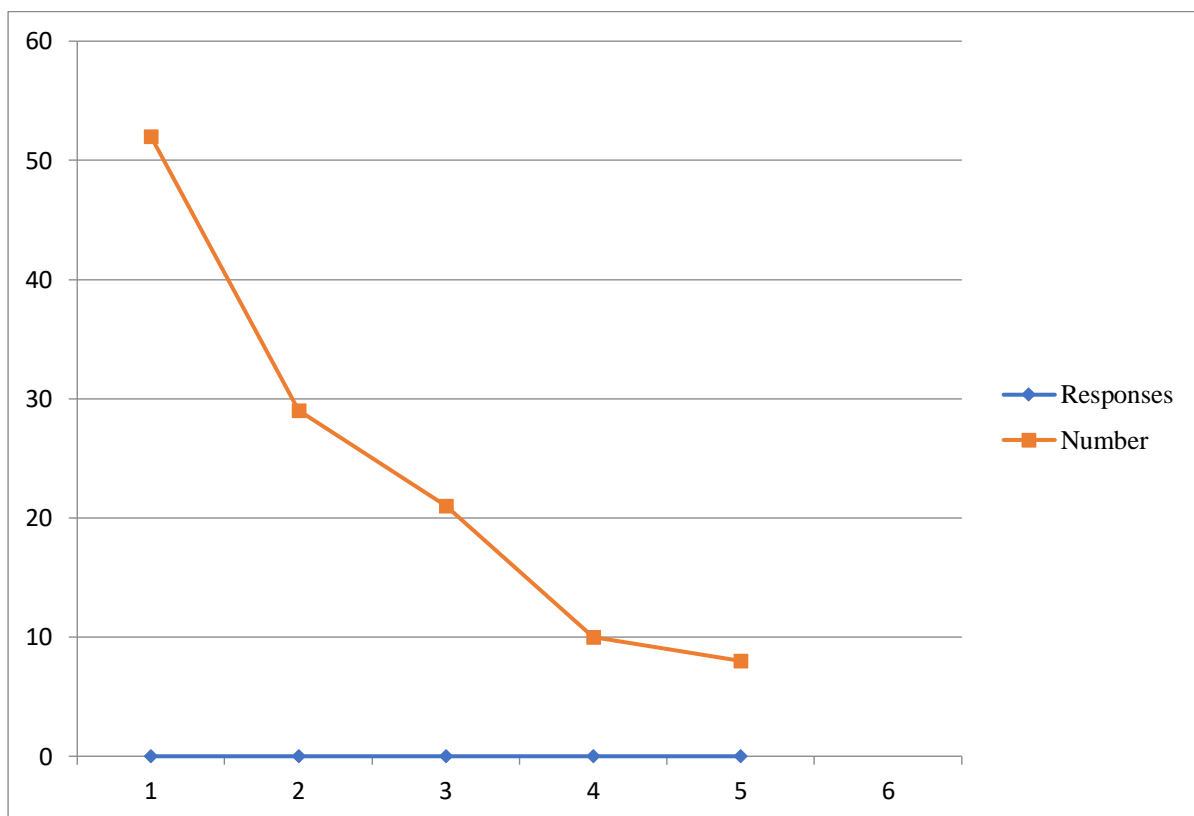

Feedback on support and response of teaching staff

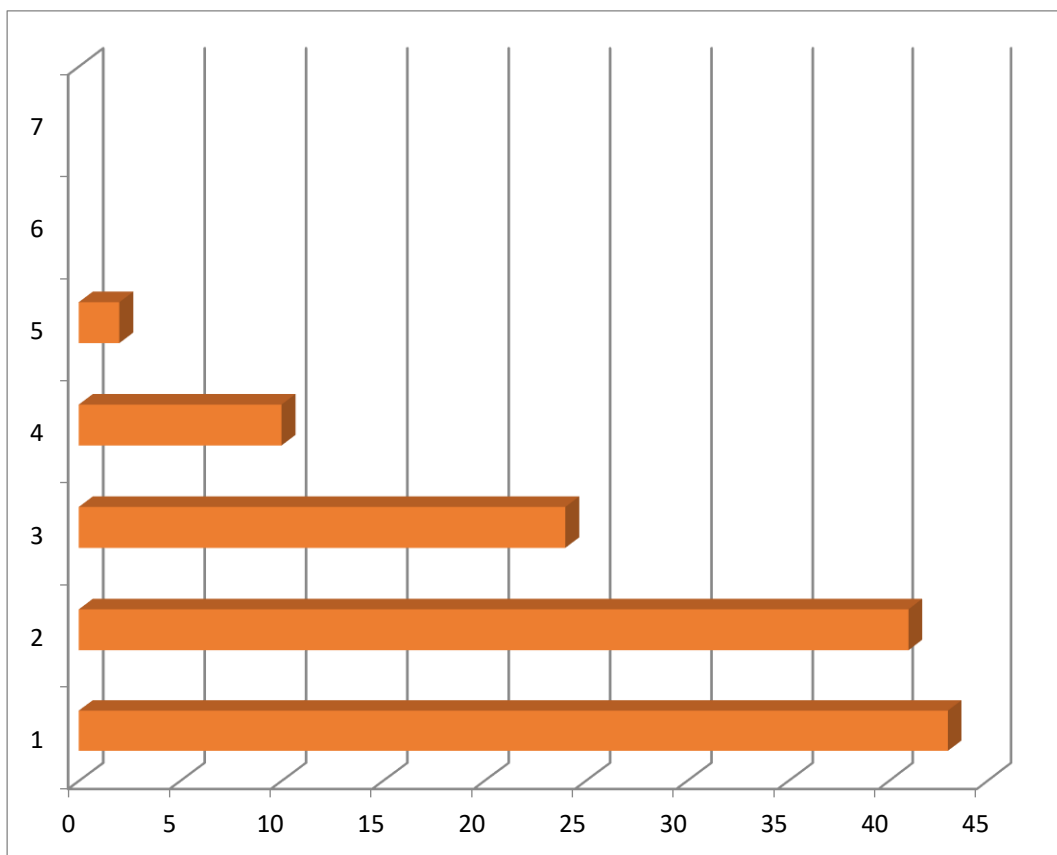

Feedback on support and response of non-teaching staff

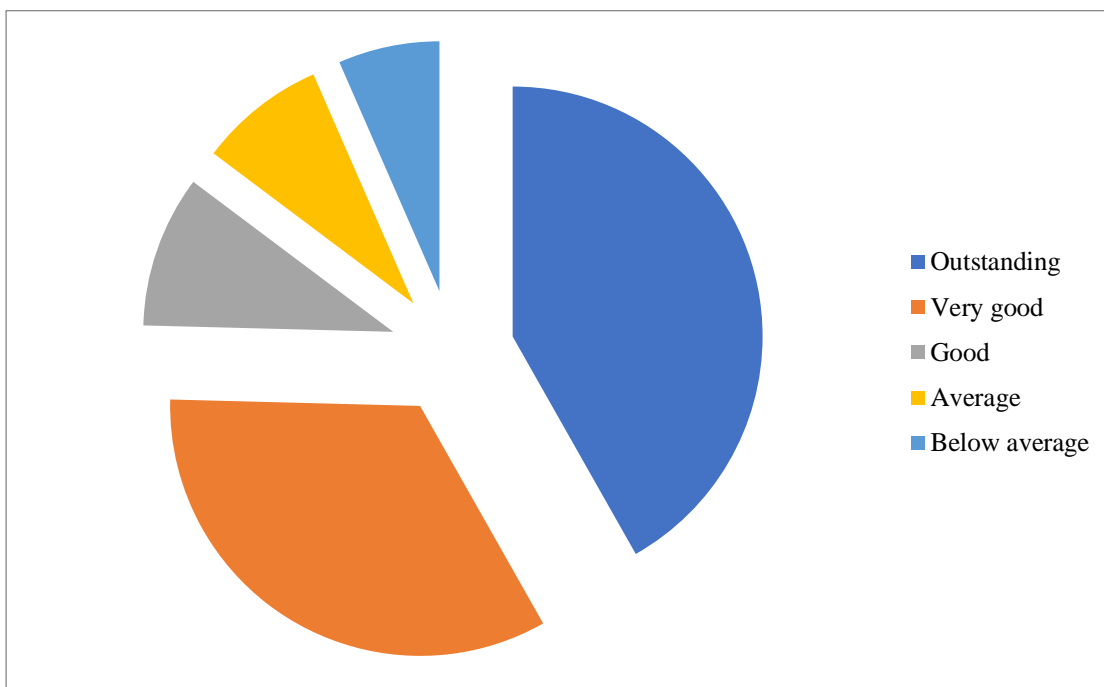


7. Feedback on management of the College
