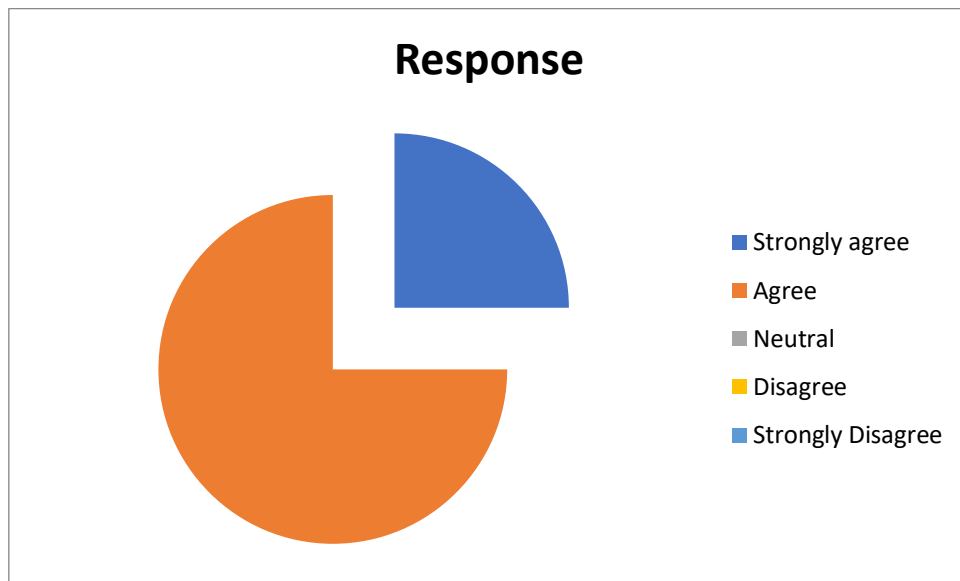

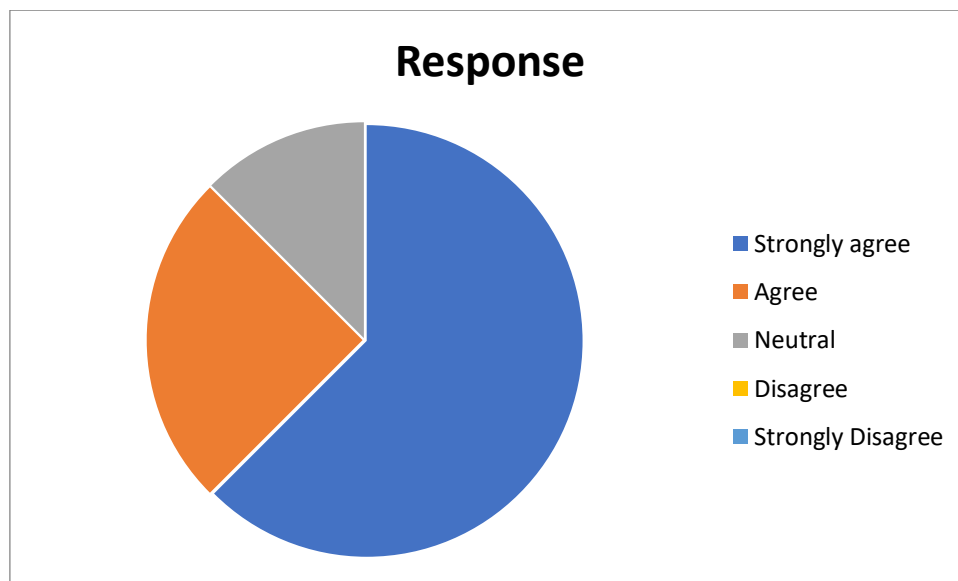

Figure: 2 Graphical representation of Table-2



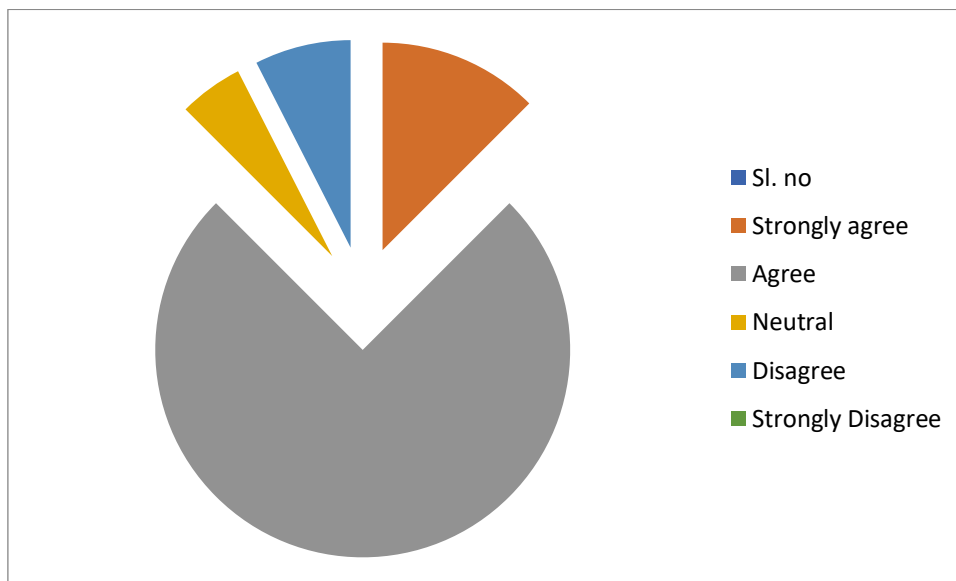

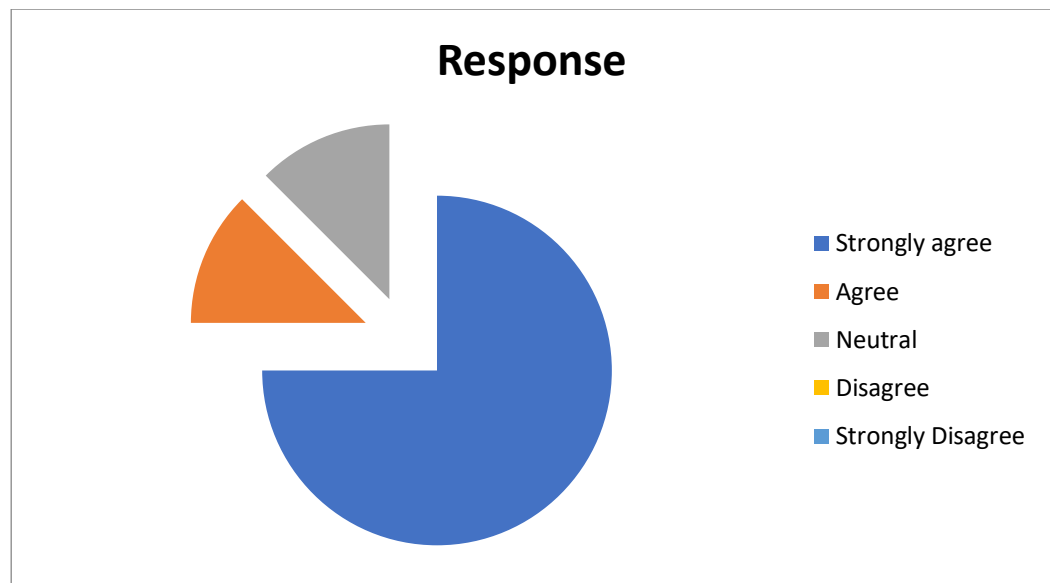

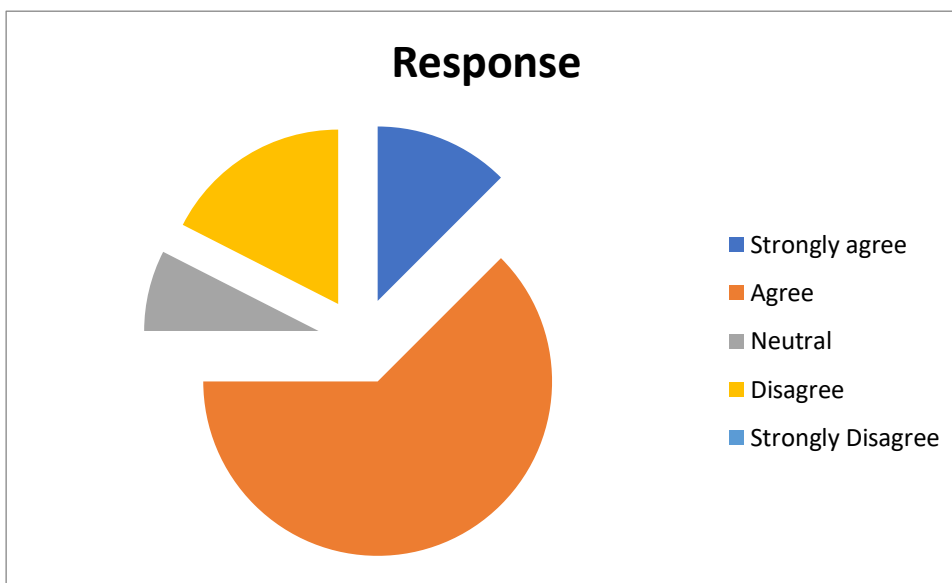

Figure: 5 Graphical representation of Table-5



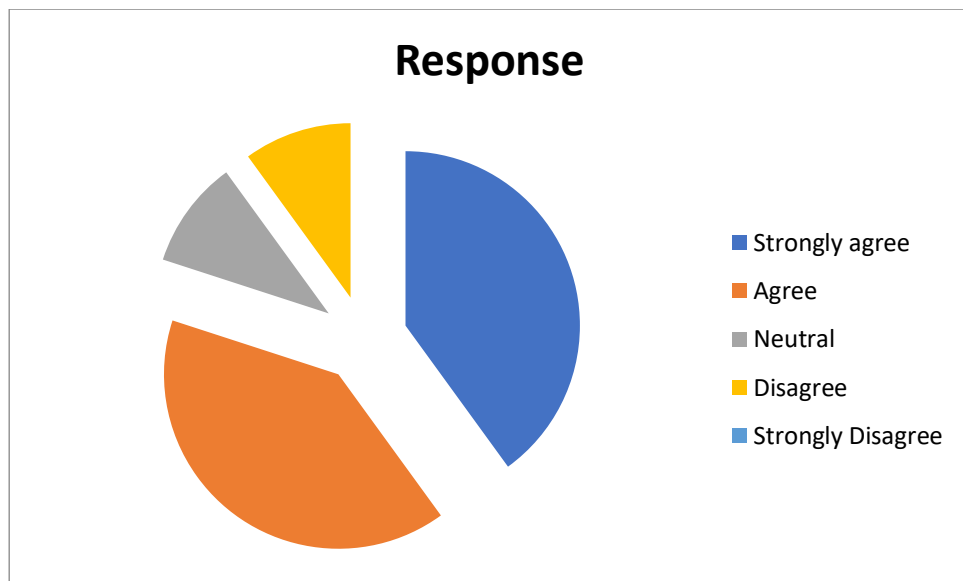

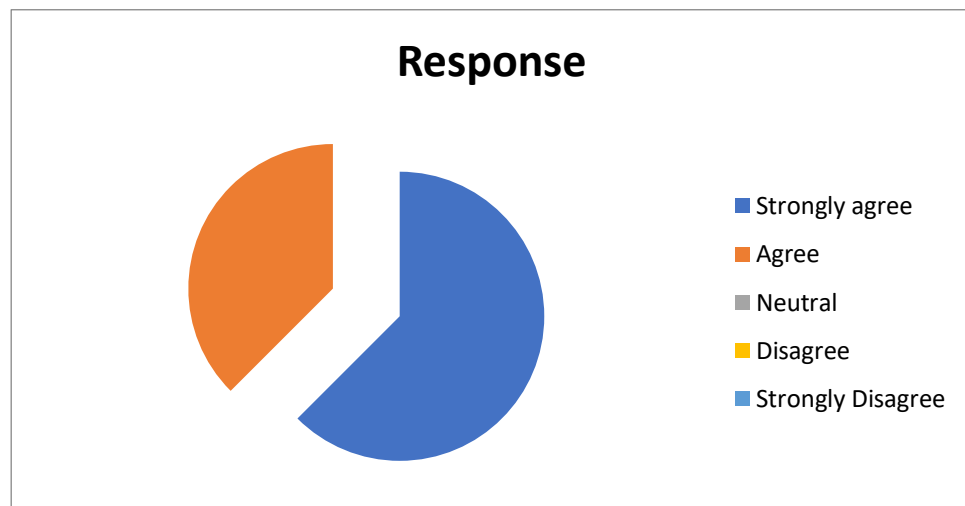

Figure: 7 Graphical representation of Table-7



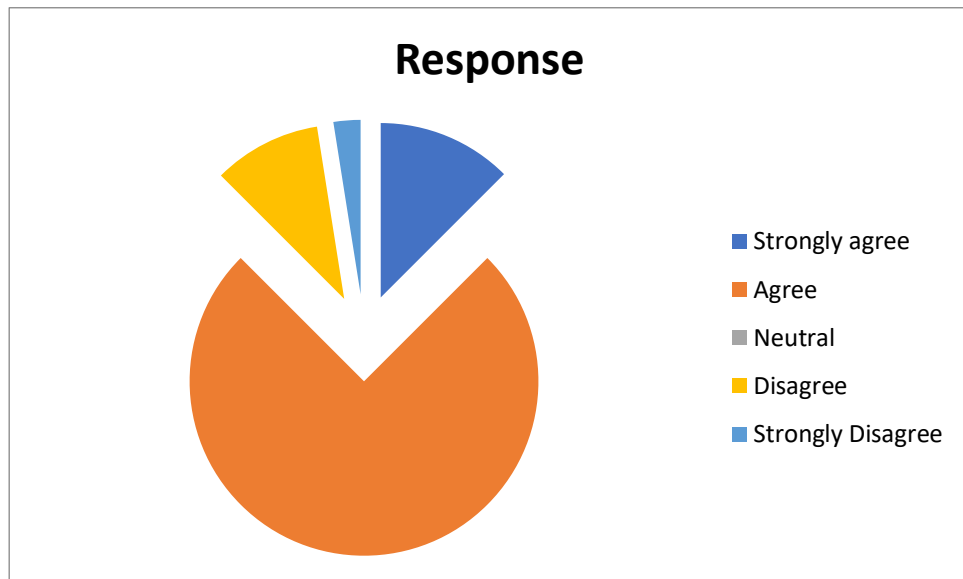

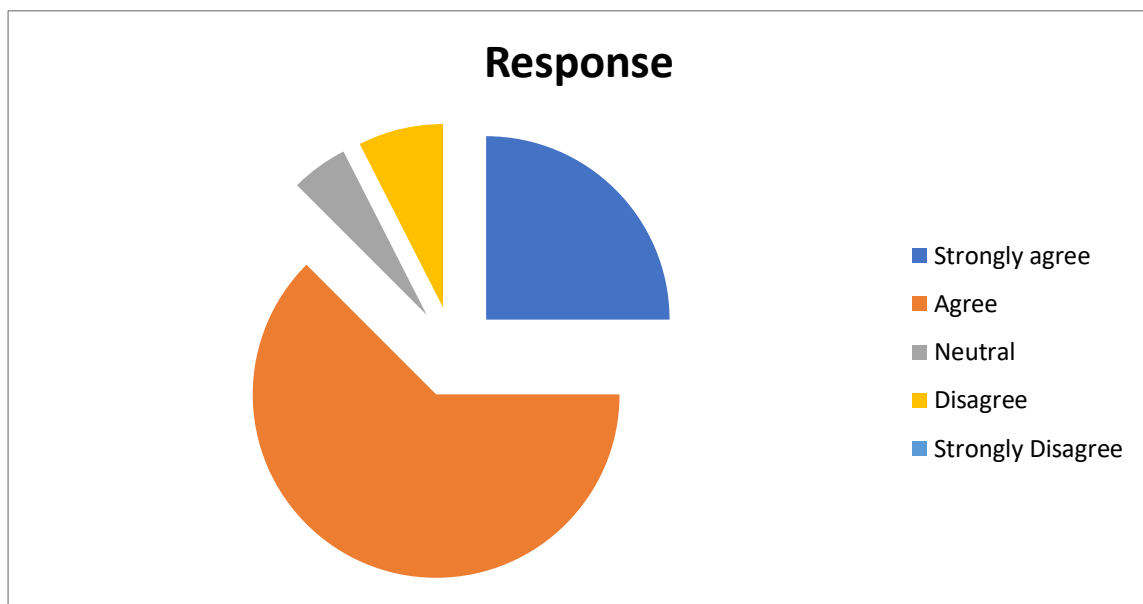

Figure: 9 Graphical representation of Table-9



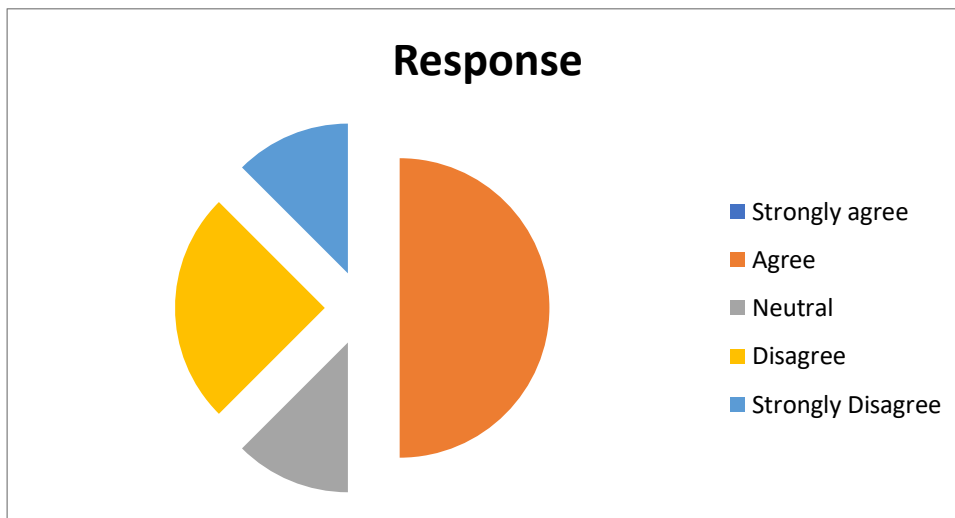

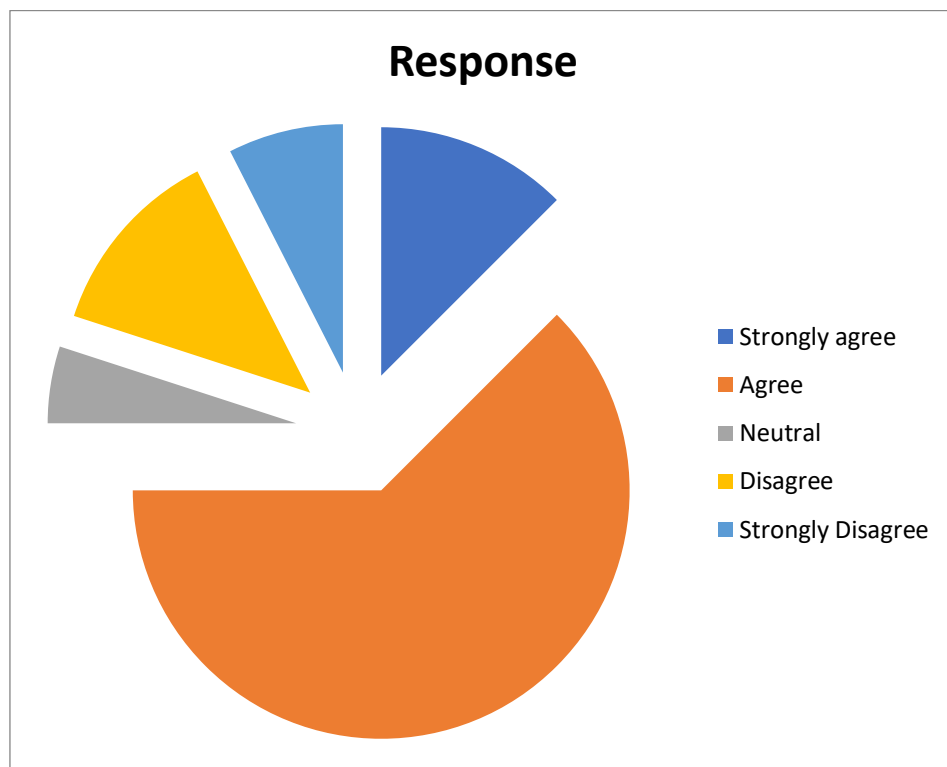

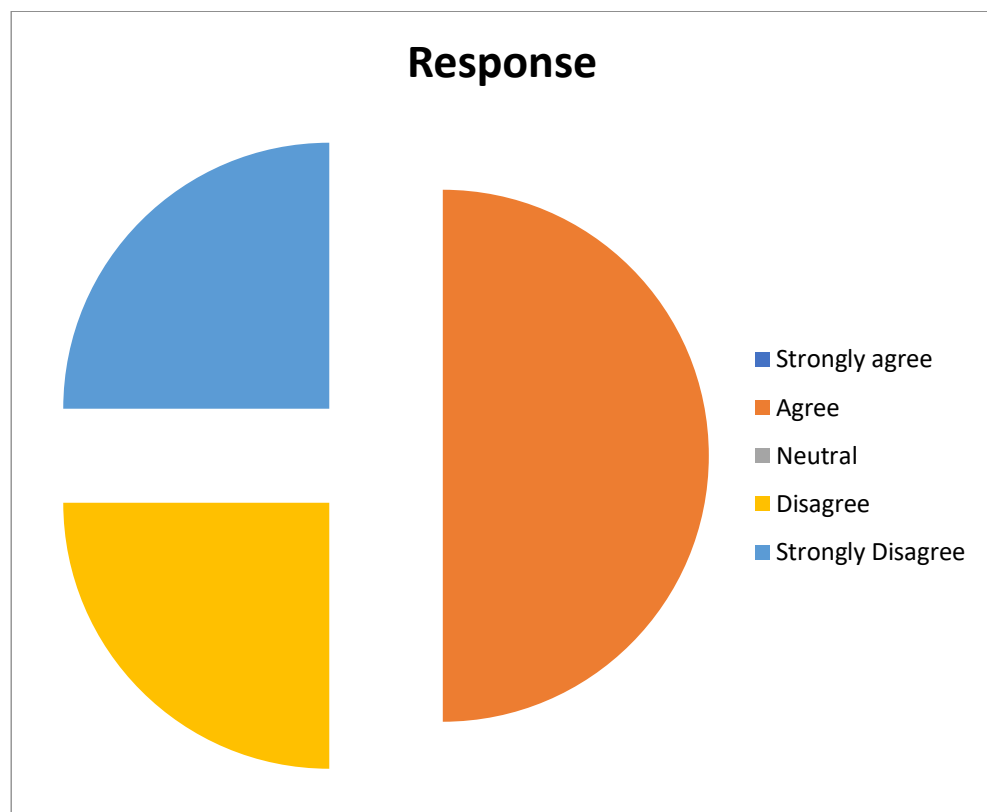

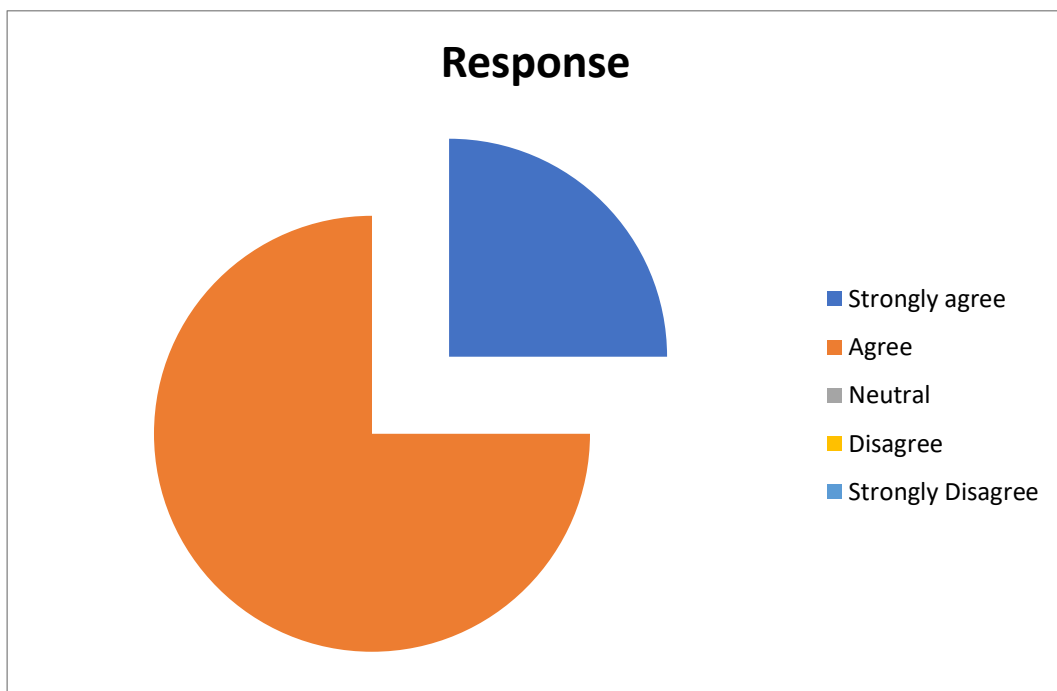

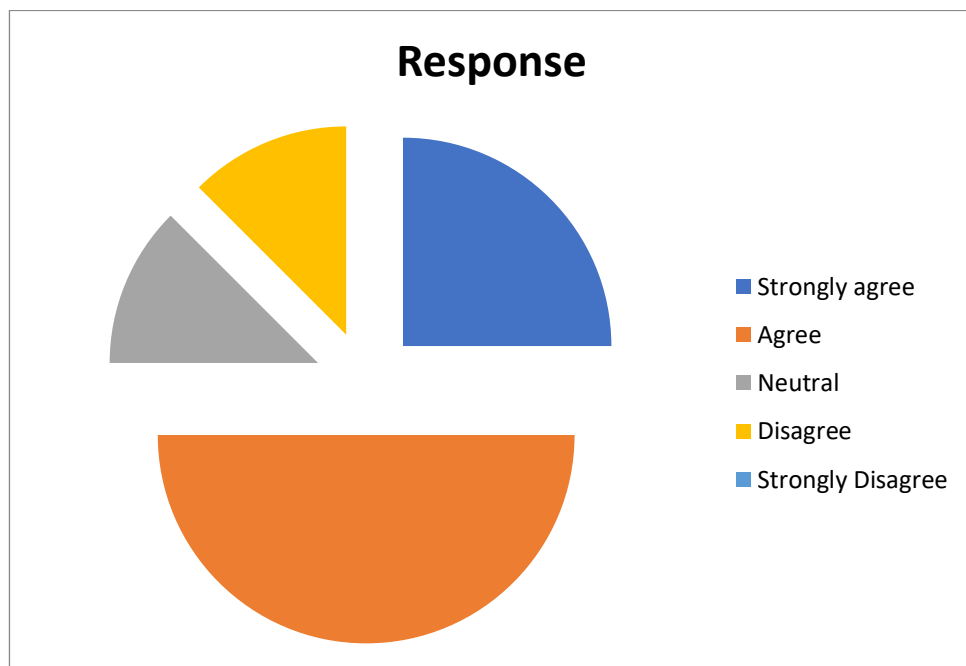

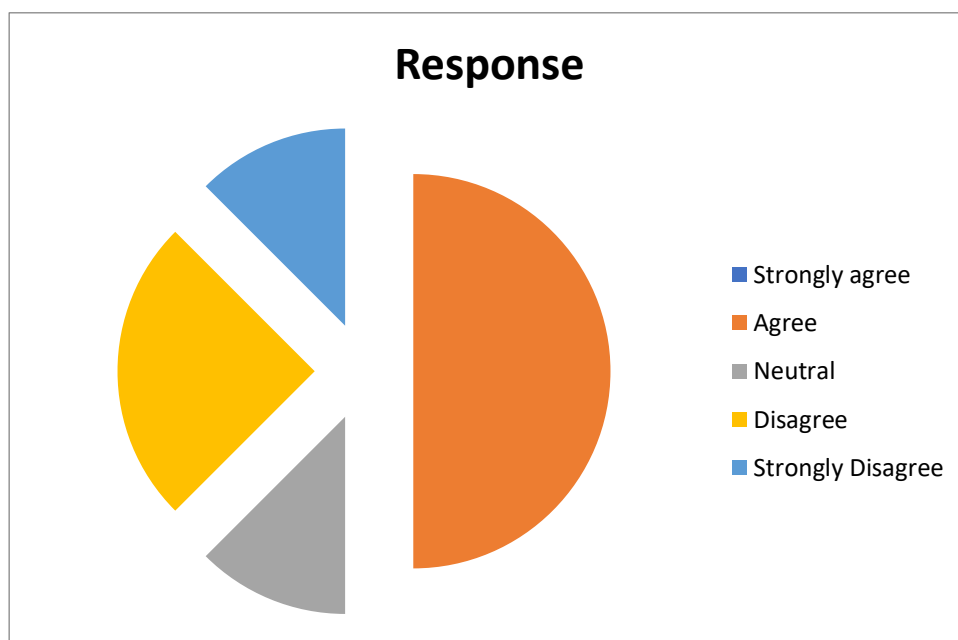
